Winemaker's Notes:

Colour: straw-yellow with typical greenish hues.

Nose: wide, delightful, wildflowers, almonds scent, white and yellow fruits such as apple, pear, plum and gooseberry.

Palate: fresh, dry, harmonic and pleasantly fruity, intense, smooth with a good body and mineral pleasant aftertaste of almond and green apple.

Serving temperature: 8-10 ° C.

Cellaring: 3-4 years.

Vineyard Information:

Various vineyards, vineyard av. age of 10-25 years old, guyot training system.
Yield: 9500 kg per ha.

Winemaking Information:

After the soft pressing of the grapes, it follows the fermentation in temperature controlled tanks. The wine stays on its own lees until the bottling with periodically "batonage".
